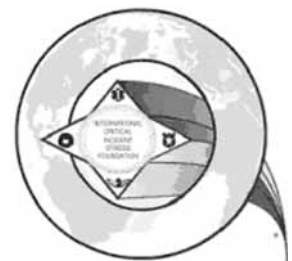

Course: This two-day course will provide participants with an understanding of a wide range of crisis intervention services including pre and post incident crisis education, significant other support services, on-scene support services and crisis intervention for individuals. This course also covers demobilizations after large scale traumatic incidents, small group defusings and the group intervention known as **Critical Incident Stress Debriefing (CISD)**. This Basic CISM course specifically prepares participants for providing several of these interventions, specifically demobilizations, defusings and the CISD.

Instructor: Course will be taught by ICISF instructor Michael R. Cobb, B.A. Ed., B.C.E.T.S. Michael Cobb currently serves as a Captain with the Richland, Washington Police Department. Captain Cobb has 18 years experience as a member of the special weapons and tactics (SWAT) team and served as a K-9 handler for 9 years. Capt. Cobb provides CISM specialty team services to the WSTOA. Mike is a faculty member with the International Critical Incident Stress Foundation and serves on the ICISF's Speakers Bureau and International Advisory Committee. Captain Cobb is a Board Certified Expert in Traumatic Stress and a Diplomate member of the American Academy of Experts in Traumatic Stress.
