Instructor: Course will be taught by ICISF instructor Michael R. Cobb, B.A. Ed., B.C.E.T.S. Michael Cobb currently serves as a Captain with the Richland, Washington Police Department. Captain Cobb has 18 years experience as a member of the special weapons and tactics (SWAT) team and served as a K-9 handler for 9 years.

Captain Cobb provides CISM specialty team to the WSTOA. Mike is a faculty member with the International Critical Incident Stress Foundation and serves on the ICISF's Speakers Bureau and International Advisory Committee. Captain Cobb is a Board Certified Expert in Traumatic Stress and a Diplomat member of the American Academy of Experts in Traumatic Stress.

Course: The Advanced CISM training program has been designed to provide participants with the latest information on critical incident stress management techniques and post-trauma syndromes. The program emphasizes a broadening of the knowledge base concerning critical incident stress interventions as well as Post Traumatic Stress Disorder which was established in the basic program and/or in publications.

At the conclusion of this educational program the participants will have been exposed to specific, proven strategies to intervene with those suffering the ill effects of their exposure to trauma. The emphasis will be on advanced defusings and debriefings in complex situations.
